



The Oklahoma Public Employees Relations Board on this 26th day of December, 1979, having been presented with a Petition from Local 2651, International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL/CIO CLC, requesting certification as the exclusive bargaining agent for the fire fighters of the Town of Bixby does hereby order and certify that Local 2651, I.A.F.F., AFL/CIO CLC shall be the exclusive bargaining agent for all permanent paid fire fighters of the Town of Bixby, excluding the Fire Chief and his designated Administrative Assistant; Further, that Local 2651, I.A.F.F. shall be entitled to recognition by the corporate authorities of the Town of Bixby for the purposes of collective bargaining and shall be entitled to the exercise of all rights, duties, and privileges of its status as exclusive employee representative for the aforementioned bargaining unit.

The Board does enter this Order pursuant to its independent investigation and based upon the following findings of fact:

1. The Board is in possession of a Petition for representation and employee authorization cards filed herewith showing that over 50% of all eligible fire fighters desire representation by Local 2651, International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL/CIO CLC.
2. No question of representation exists.
3. The Town of Bixby, upon notification of petition to city and right to hearing from the PERB, and following hearings held on November 14, 1979 and November 27, 1979, agrees to hold a representative election as requested in said petition.
4. The City held an election on December 12, 1979, for all employees eligible to vote in a representative election and has challenged no employee. Ten (10) employees voted in favor of Local 2651, International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL/CIO CLC; and No (-0-) employees voted in favor of no representative.
5. The Town of Bixby possesses knowledge of the majority status of Local 2651 and there exists no bona fide doubt as to such status.





Dear Mr. Emrich:

I have been informed by a representative of the Professional Fire Fighters of Oklahoma, to which the Chickasha Local belongs, that the recognized collective bargaining agent for the Fire Fighters of Chickasha sent a request by certified mail, to meet and confer with the corporate authorities of Chickasha

Pursuant to the Fire and Police Arbitration Act of the Oklahoma Municipal Code found at 11 O.S. 1978, §51-101, the respective rights and responsibilities of public employees and public employers are specifically set out. Under §51-105, an obligation is placed upon the municipality "to meet at reasonable times and confer in good faith with the representatives of the Fire Fighters...within ten days after receipt of written notice of said collective bargaining agent requesting a meeting for collective bargaining purposes." Please be informed that this provision of the law is of particular importance due to the fact that municipalities are under a limited period of time, within which they may appropriate monies to cover any contracted increase in wages.

The collective bargaining representative of the Chickasha Fire Fighters has complied with the letter of the law in submitting to you in good faith, the aforementioned request to bargain. If no response is received from your office instanter, inaction will be taken as a refusal to bargain constituting an unfair labor practice.

We will not hesitate to seek redress of our rights under the Act if it is apparent that the City of Chickasha will continue to disregard the law.
